Dear Diary:

When I was a young woman, aged 19, I worked in the International Building at Rockefeller Center.

One lunch hour (this was about 1966), Tallulah Bankhead and a young male escort were frozen in place in front of the revolving doors, which were, at the time, the only access into the building.

She was pleading with the young man to find another entrance: "Dahling, I just cahn't. ... Don't make me. ... I cahn't go through those doors."

I have no idea if she ever made it inside, but I will never forget her voice as it boomed dramatically across the open area at the front of the building, causing many to stop and stare.
